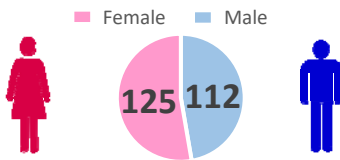
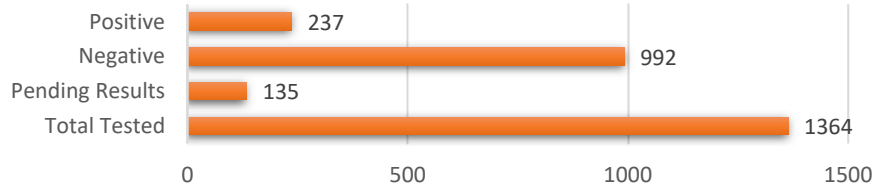

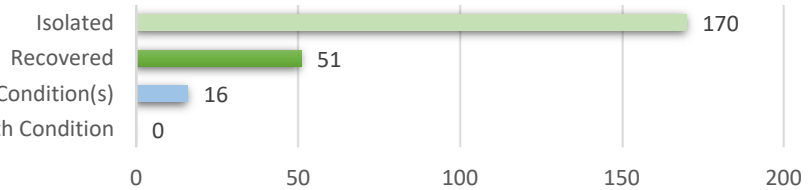

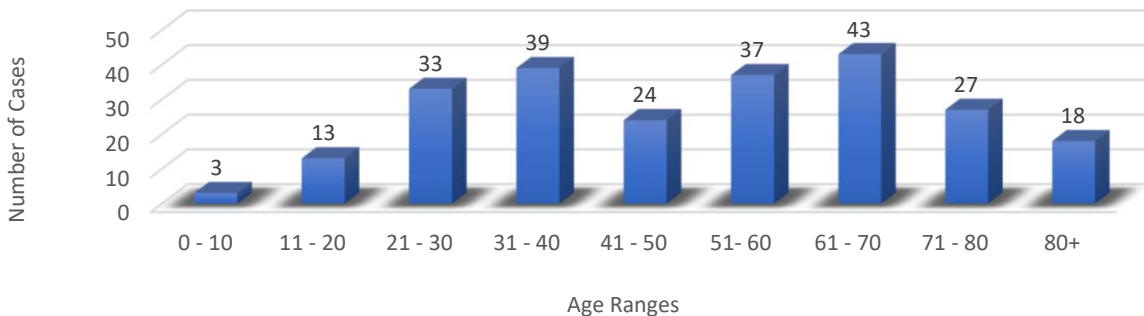
Status* of COVID-Test
