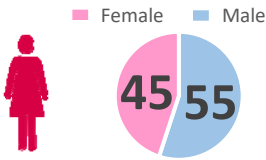
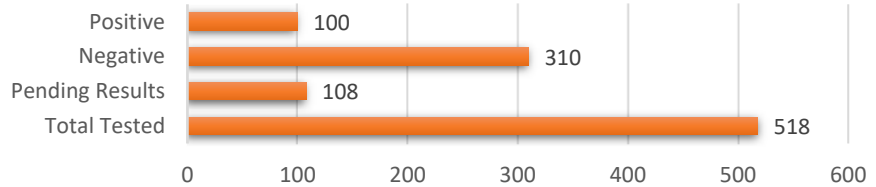

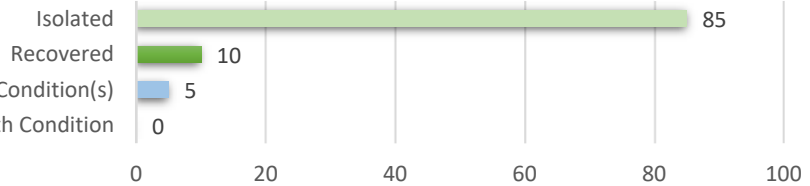

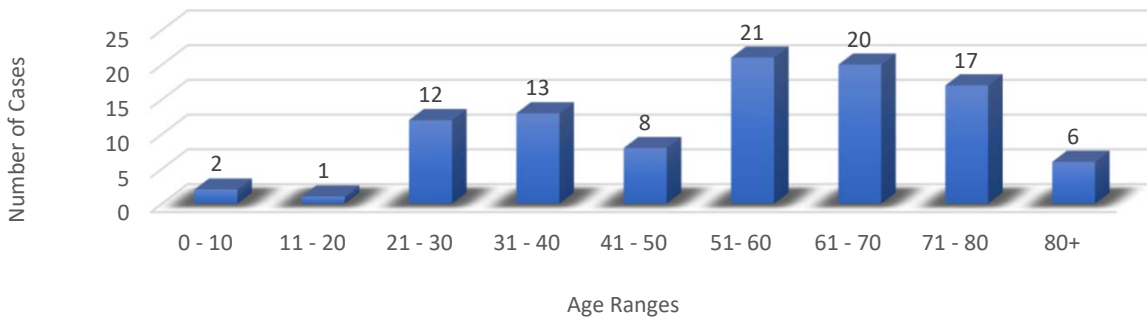
Status* of COVID-Test

New info on Daily Update: Deaths with and without underlying health conditions is now included.

Governor Greg Abbott extended his original disaster declaration for all Texas counties on April 12. It extends the declaration for 30 days pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 418.014. The disaster declaration is NOT the same as his Stay Home executive order GA-14. That order will expire on April 30 unless renewed.
