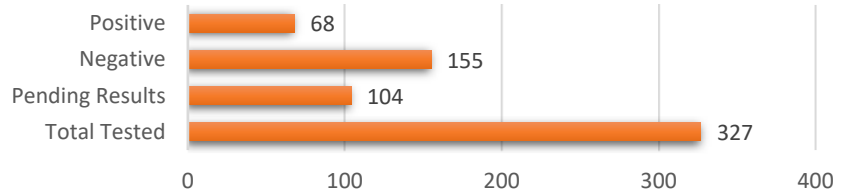

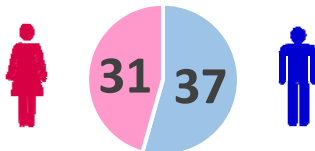

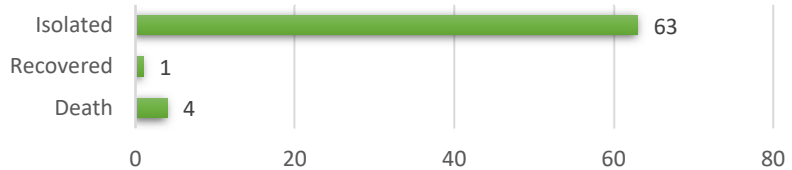
Status* of COVID-Test



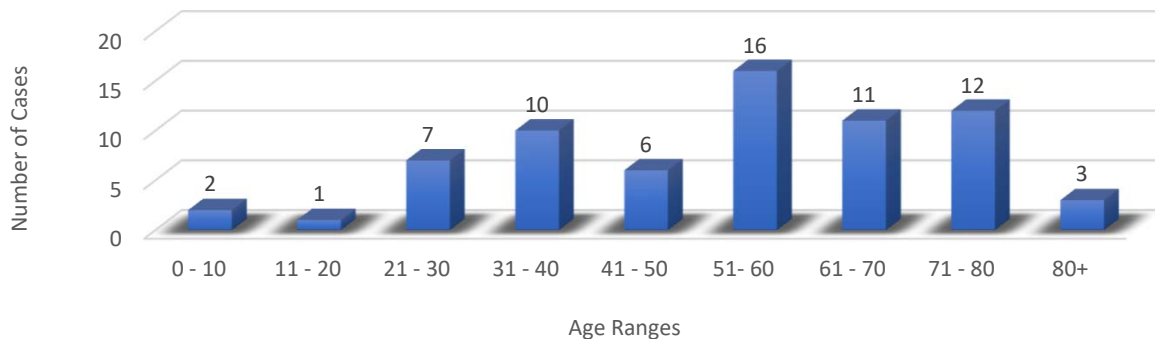
Female Male
