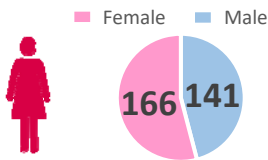
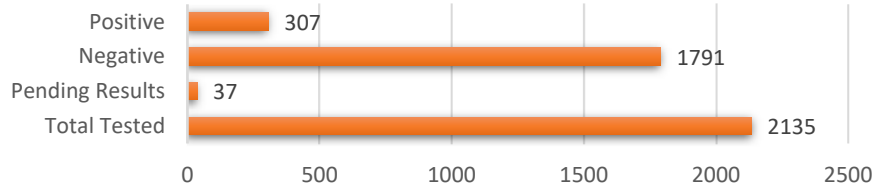

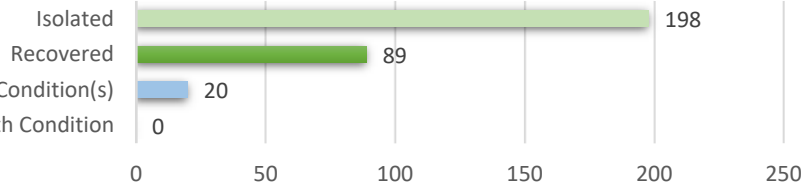

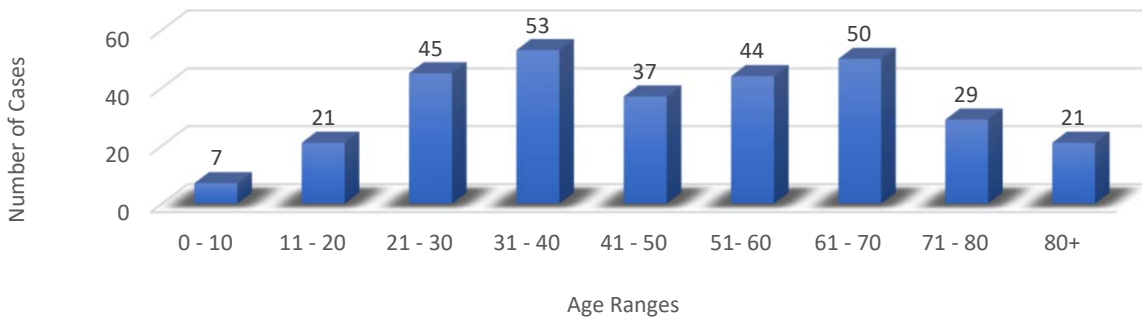
### Status\* of COVID-Test
