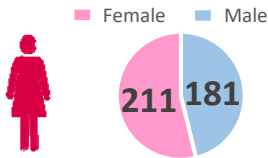
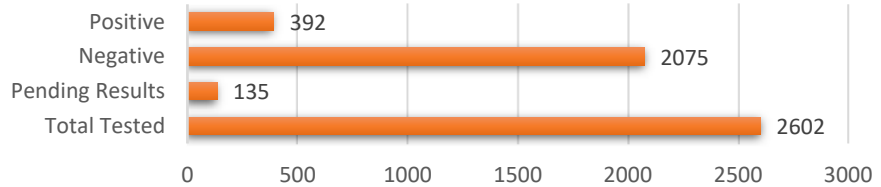

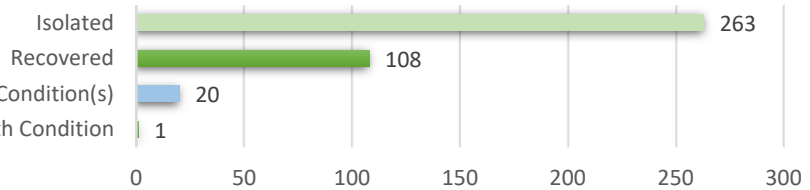

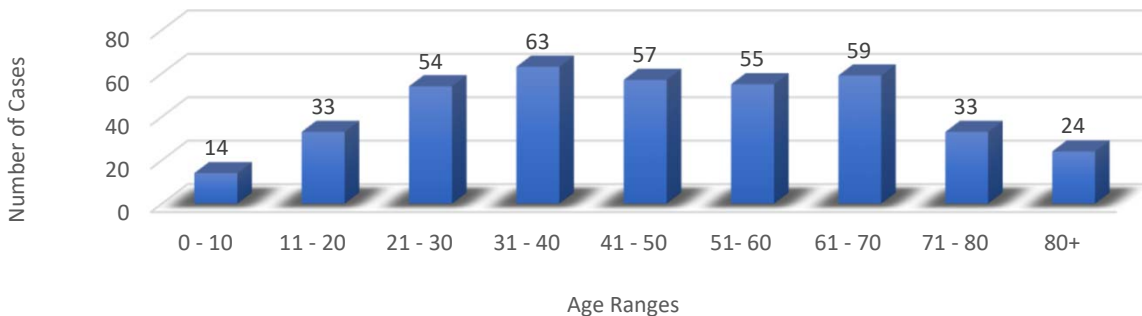
Status* of COVID-Test



Status of Confirmed Cases



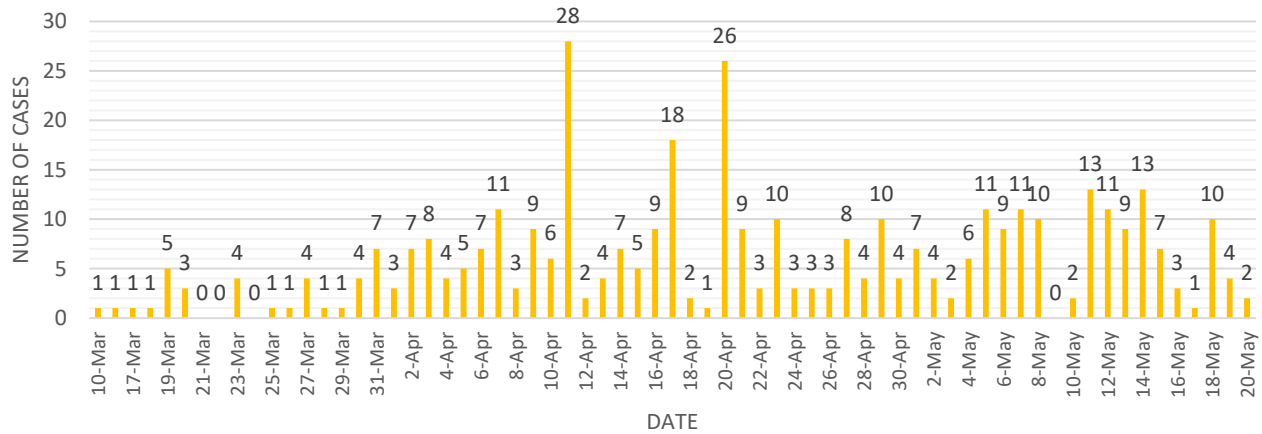
Confirmed Cases by Age Range
