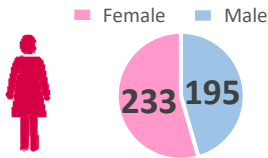
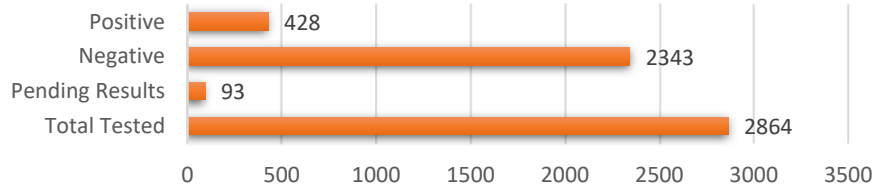

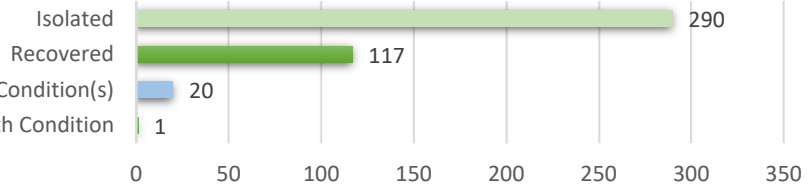

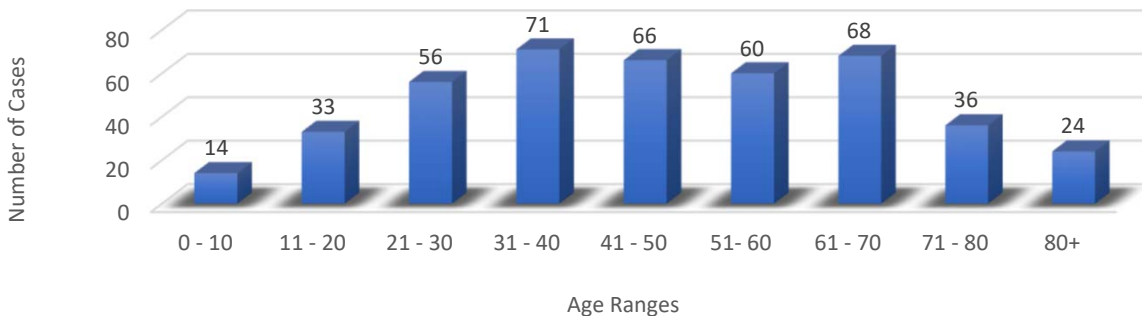
### Status\* of COVID-Test



### Status of Confirmed Cases



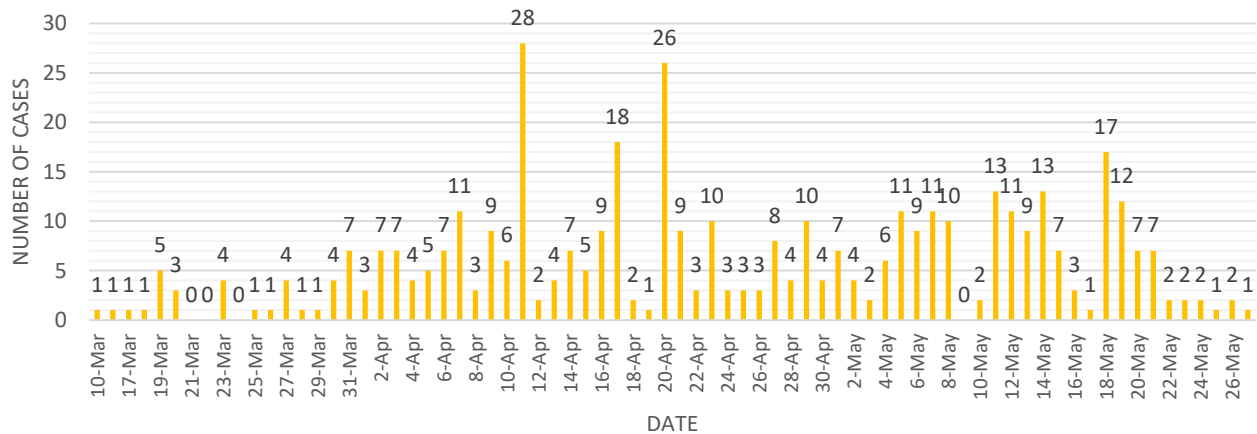
### Confirmed Cases by Age Range

## Updated Status of City Facility Re-openings:

City operated playgrounds- Open

Convention and Visitors Bureau- Planning to re-open June 1<sup>st</sup>

Tyrrell Historical Library- Planning to re-open June 8<sup>th</sup>

City Hall- Planning to re-open June 8<sup>th</sup>

City Athletic Complex- Re-opening for softball practices on May 31<sup>st</sup> and games or tournaments could begin June 15<sup>th</sup>

The following will remain open: Tennis Center, Henry Homberg Golf Course, Municipal Transit, City parks, Elmo Willard Library, Theodore Johns Library, and the Miller Library. No special events will be scheduled at these facilities.

The following City facilities will remain closed at this time: The Downtown Library, Civic Center, Event Centre, Julie Rogers Theatre, Jefferson Theatre, Lakeside Center, Sterling Pruitt Center, Community Centers, and the Municipal Court.

City operated swimming pools and splash pads remain closed at this time.

City operated basketball courts remain closed at this time.
