## TEMPORARY OUTDOOR OPERATIONS PERMIT GUIDELINES

Due to social distancing requirements of the Governor's executive order, the City understands that some restaurant establishments will seek alternatives to their existing indoor and outdoor configurations by extending operations to new outdoor areas including sidewalks, parking lots, etc. In an effort to ensure that social distancing requirements are met, the City is providing the following flexible outdoor operations allowances as an option:

- **Permit**- A Temporary Outdoor Restaurant Operations Permit application shall be sent via e-mail to [Building\\_Codes@beaumonttexas.gov](mailto:Building_Codes@beaumonttexas.gov) . The permit will be effective for 90 days. The property owner must give written consent to the application.
- **Occupancy**- New outdoor operations will not result in an occupancy greater than the originally approved occupancy limit for the restaurant.
- **ADA Requirements**- No temporary outdoor operations shall be placed on a sidewalk unless an accessible path is available.
- **Life Safety Requirements**- At least one 2A10BC rated fire extinguisher shall be provided for the outdoor operations using any number of tents. Points of ingress and egress shall not be blocked for any reason.
- **Tents**- Properly secured tents are allowed. Please note that tents greater than 200 square feet will require a separate Tent Permit, reviewed and approved by Beaumont Fire-Rescue.
- **Traffic & Parking**- New outdoor operations cannot interfere with normal vehicle traffic movement to include fire department access to the building and access to fire hydrants and other firefighting equipment.
- **Health Department Requirements** -Food preparation must be done inside the restaurant kitchen facilities. Dining must occur on the property/lease area of the restaurant.
