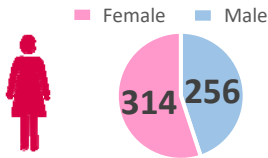
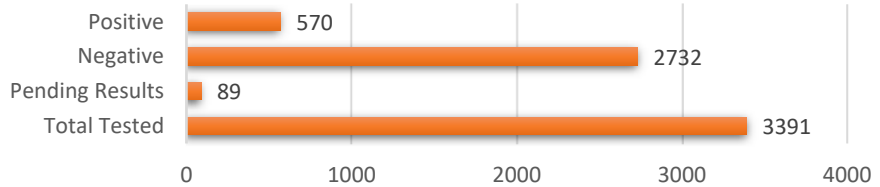

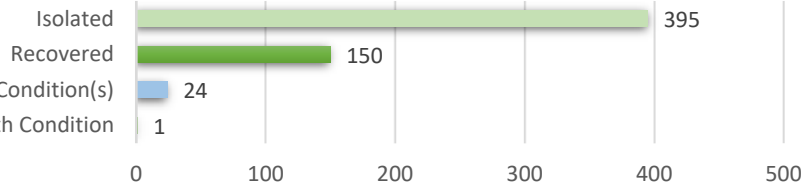

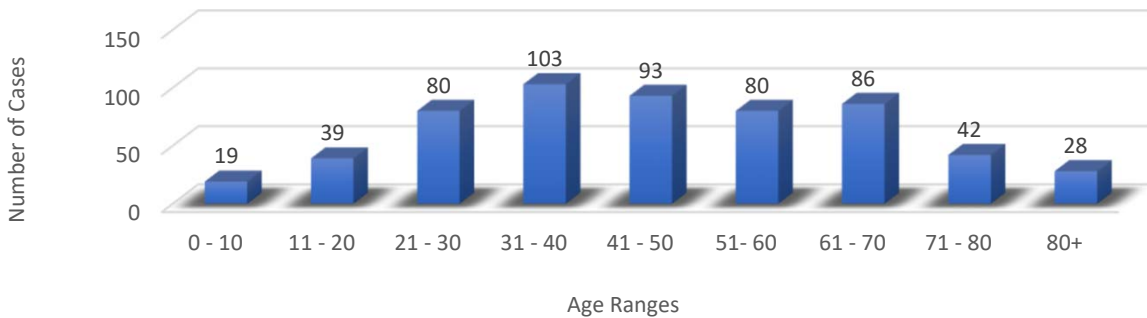
### Status\* of COVID-Test



### Status of Confirmed Cases



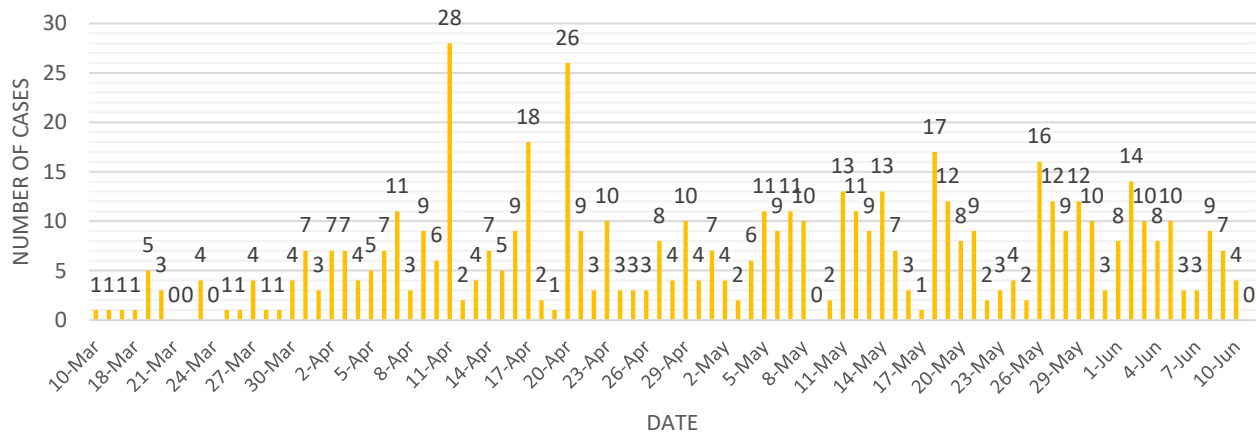
### Confirmed Cases by Age Range

## A message from Mayor Becky Ames, June 11, 2020:

Due to increased accessibility to COVID-19 testing, the numbers of positive cases in the Beaumont area have increased. The negative results outweigh the positive results, but we as a community need to remain vigilant and continue to adhere to social distancing recommendations and wear masks to help stop the spread.

Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) inmate COVID-19 cases have been added to our local county numbers. As a result, jurisdictions where TDCJ facilities are located will see a large increase in their reported number of cases. TDCJ does not report inmate results to local health departments, so that information will not be added to our daily reporting, however, TDCJ employees that test positive are reported to local health departments.
