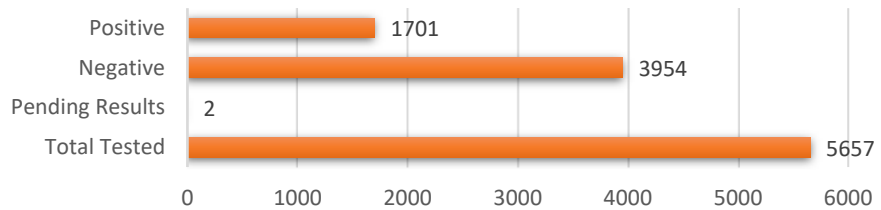

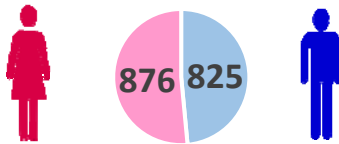

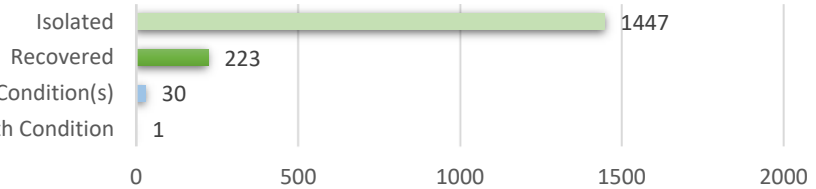

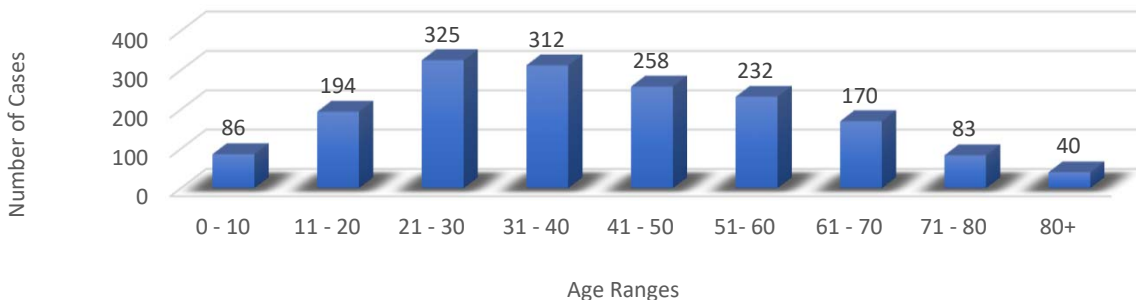

Confirmed Cases by Age Range

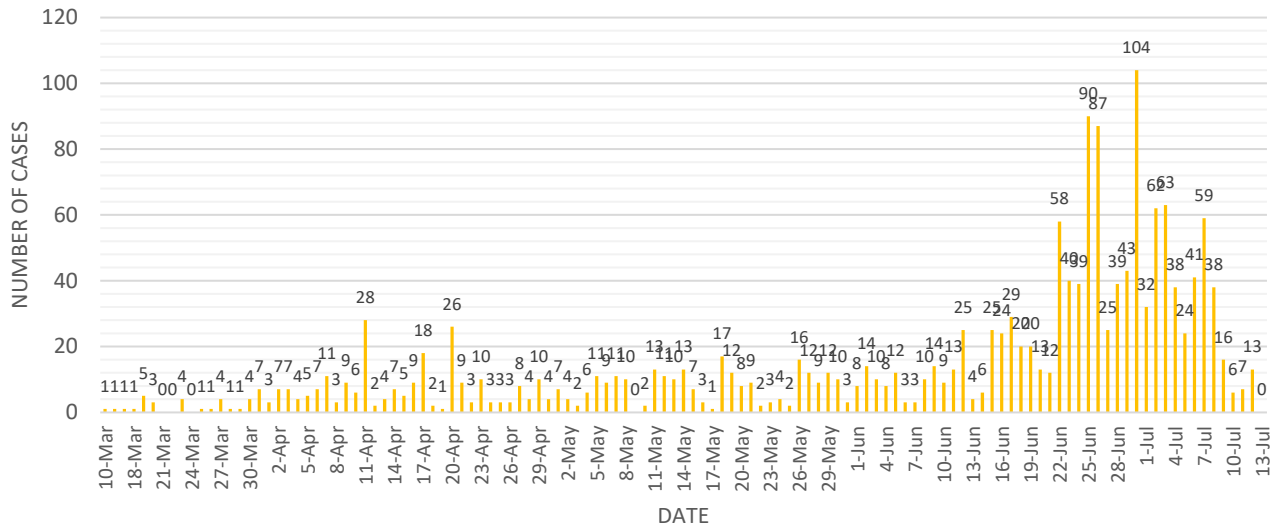
