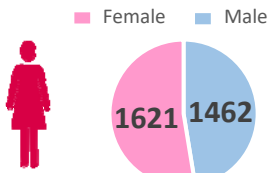
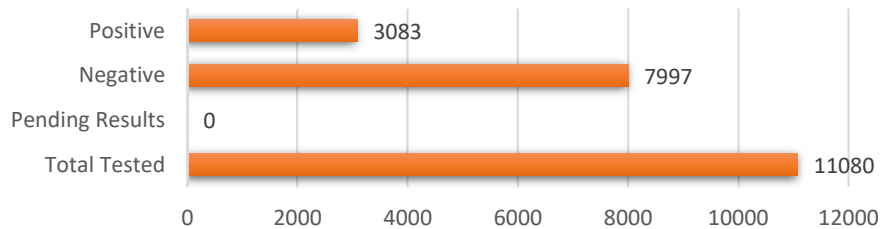

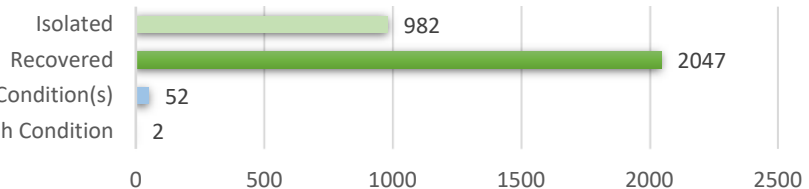

Status* of COVID-Test

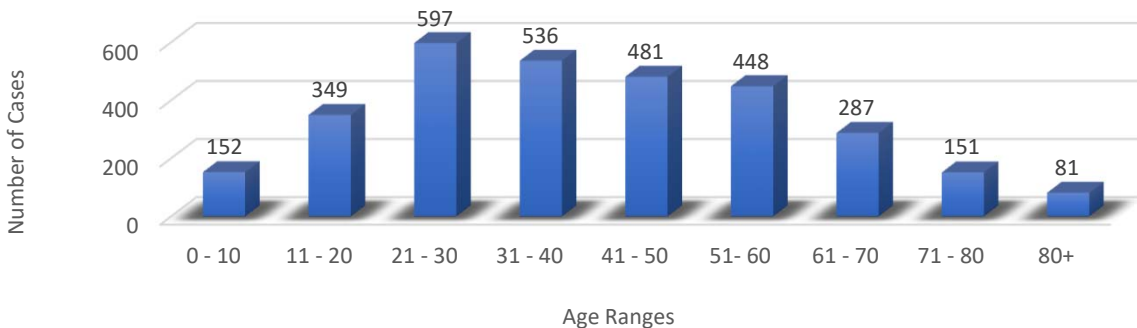

Status of Confirmed Cases



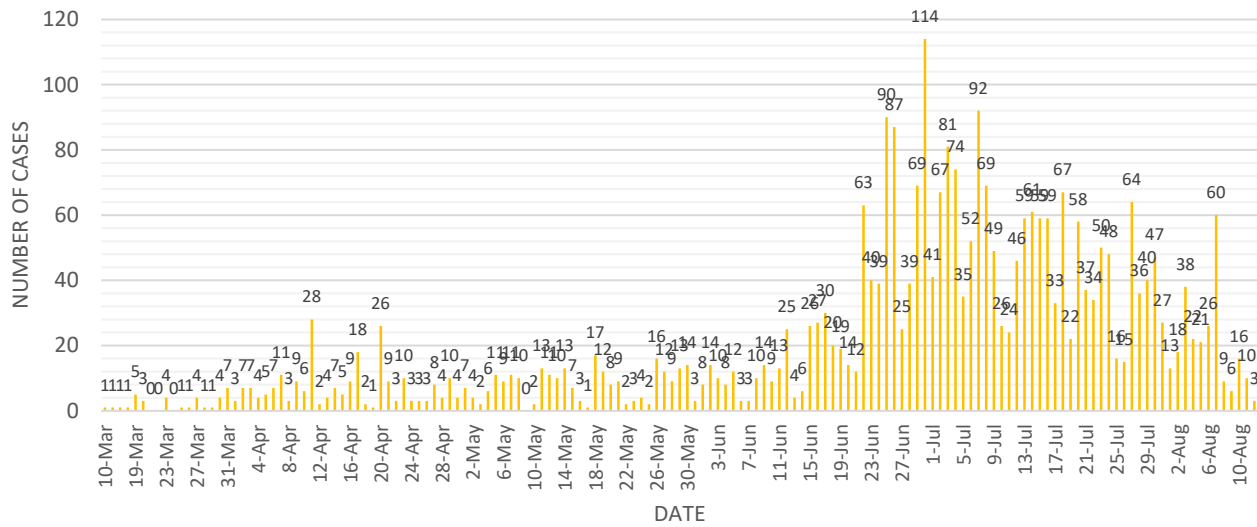
Confirmed Cases by Age Range

A message from Mayor Becky Ames, August 12, 2020:

- Remember to clean and disinfect surfaces that you often touch. Covid-19 may spread from touching a surface or object with the virus on it and then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes. Surfaces you may want to consider disinfecting often would include doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- The National Guard Mobile Testing Team is conducting community Covid-19 testing all week at the Central High School Girls Gym. Please see the next page for more details.
- Persons who test positive for Covid-19 are encouraged to purchase a pulse oximeter to monitor their oxygen saturation. For a reading of 93, persons are encouraged to notify their physician. If the oxygen level drops below 92, persons are encouraged to seek medical attention immediately. Pulse oximeters are available for about \$25.00 on Amazon.com.
- We are working towards organizing additional community Covid-19 Testing for the month of August. Please also refer to the list of private facilities that offer Covid-19 testing in Beaumont on the next page of this report.
