"The route weaves through the historic Old Town District paying homage to Beaumont's past and future. There will be awards for overall male, overall female, as well as 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place finishers in each five-year age group, but everyone is encouraged to participate. The age groups are as follows: 1-9, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70+.
