

Downloading Data off the City of Beaumont ArcGIS Online Map

All of the city's available GIS data is hosted through ArcGIS Online. It is the live, most up-to-date geospatial data the city currently has. If you would like to download this data for academic purposes, please take the following steps:

Navigate to the ArcGIS Online map of the city's public data and locate the desired layer. Mouse-over that layer's title and click on the "more options" icon. Now select "Show Item Details".

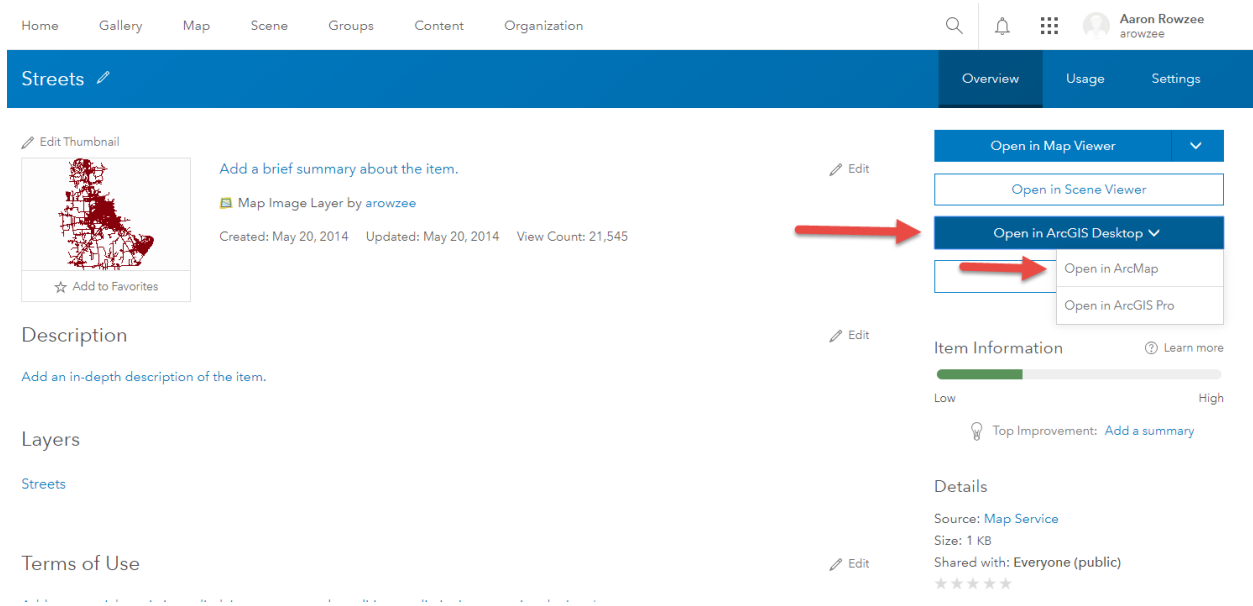

Once the “Item Details” page has opened, most likely in a new browser tab, you will click on “Open in ArcGIS Desktop” on the right-hand side of the page. Next, you will choose ArcMap for a ‘.lyr’ file or ArcGIS Pro for a ‘item.pitemx’ file.



Once your file is downloaded, it can be imported into ArcGIS Desktop, Pro, or other compatible geospatial software.
